PC Flex ACOs are required to publicly publish their Spend Plans, to ensure additional accountability and transparency in how they are spending the Advance Shared Savings Payment and Prospective Primary Care (PPC) Payment to support the provision of primary care. These spend plans are approximate and non-binding and may differ from actual expenditures.
